References are in the form 5.3.118, which means Volume 5, Chapter 3, Page 118. Chiu's Supplement ran from Volume 1, Chapter 1 (July 1952) through Volume 12, Chapter 9 (March 1964). Each Volume has twelve Chapters (i.e. monthly parts), except for Volume 12, which has nine.

In Volumes 1 and 2 each Chapter was paginated separately, usually pages 1 to 4. From Volume 3, Chapter 1 (July 1954) onward, continuous page numbers were used.

An error was made in Volume 9, Chapter 2 (August 1960), where page 385 was followed by page 286 and one hundred page numbers were inadvertently repeated. Because of these vagaries of page numbering and to avoid ambiguity, references need to cite Volume, Chapter, and Page number.
